

REOPENING OF COLLEGE POST LOCKDOWN DUE TO COVID- 19

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS, TIMELINE FOR JOINING AND MANDATORY COVID PREVENTION GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

1. TIME LINE FOR JOINING / REPORTING BACK TO HOSTEL.

2018 BATCH – 18 Jan 2021- 19 Jan 2021

2. All students **must carry a negative RT- PCR report which should not be earlier than 48 hours, prior to the date of joining**, without which they will not be allowed to enter the hostel premises.
3. **RT- PCR test will be repeated on 7th day after arrival, the cost of which will be borne by the students.**
4. Requisite quarantine will have to be followed during which the students will stay in their rooms and will not be allowed to move outside. However, online classes will continue during the quarantine period.
5. All students will have to carry essential stores required for a period of atleast one month with them. No leave/ out pass will be sanctioned once the students rejoin the hostel.
6. Screening of students at reception centre in hostel will be conducted for symptoms of ILI (fever, cough, sore throat, malaise, diarrhoea etc) and temperature screening will be conducted at the time of entering the hostel premises.
7. Students will be allowed to join the hostel only after being declared fit at the screening counter.
8. Installation and display of Arogya Setu App shall be mandatory.

9. All students must wear a (N- 95) mask at all times when in the college or in common areas (Corridors, Mess, Library, Canteen etc).
10. Social distancing will have to be followed at all times. All students will avoid Crowds, Closed Spaces and Close Contact.
11. Students will practice frequent hand washing with soap (for atleast 30- 40 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Alternatively, alcohol based hand sanitizers may be used (for 20 seconds). This is advisable especially after returning from Classroom, Mess, Library or any after Common Area of college hostel.
12. Respiratory etiquette to be strictly followed by everyone in college and hostel premises.
13. Any student who develops symptoms (Fever, Cough, Breathing Difficulty. Malaise etc) will report to the warden immediately.
14. Attendance for all classes (offline & online) is mandatory; failing which strict disciplinary action will be taken.
15. Day-scholars will be screened whenever they come for offline classes. The schedule of offline classes will be intimated though the respective departments.
16. Students are encouraged to clear all pending dues before reporting to the college. They can utilize the newly introduced online portal for fee payment available on the College Website.
